- 1. Did the meeting start on time with all members present and attentive? **YES**

Provisional ballots--separate ID provisionals from regular provisionals; discussion of the security of the ballots as they unlock and lock the boxes as people come in to prove their ID; plan to compare the names/vote ID# to state list of driver licenses to be sure there is no fraudulent claim of not having a photo ID. Also: redistricting-- work to assign precincts is ongoing but will not be ready for public online look-up until late May. The Election Commission does have an in-house look-up that is about 98% accurate.

Do you recommend League action on any of these issues?

Continue with plans for poll watching. Be especially alert for voters who come in at 6:55 PM and claim to have no photo ID and need a provisional ballot (which takes ~45 minutes to complete)
